2018 - 2021 ARC Grant \$348K awarded: The recovery of life recorded at the end-Cretaceous impact crater, led by Kliti Grice, Marco Coolen.

Database records indicate that 104 Program-related papers with ANZIC contributors have been published in non-Program, primarily peer-reviewed serial publications. A total of 72 of these research papers (almost 70%) were published in 22 highly rated peer-reviewed journals.
