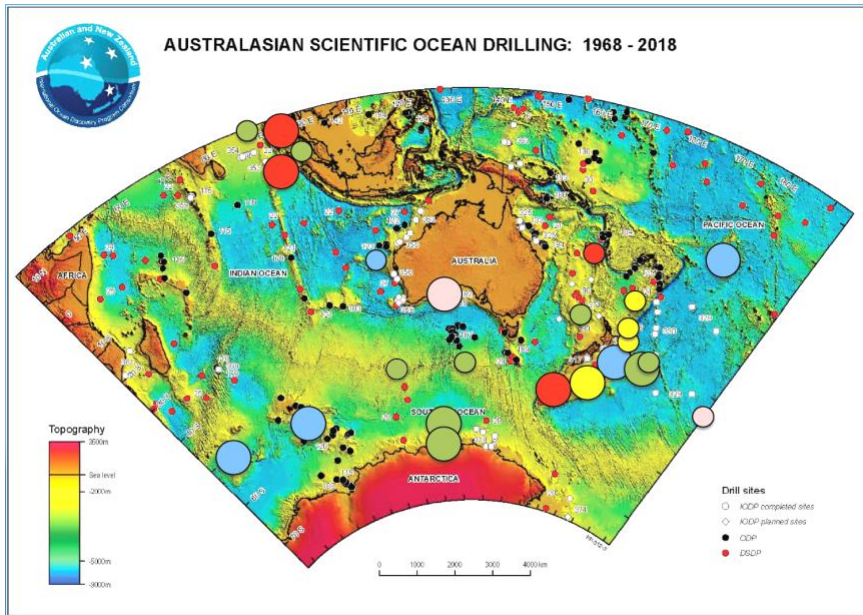


ANZIC-IODP PRE-PROPOSAL WRITING WORKSHOP CALL

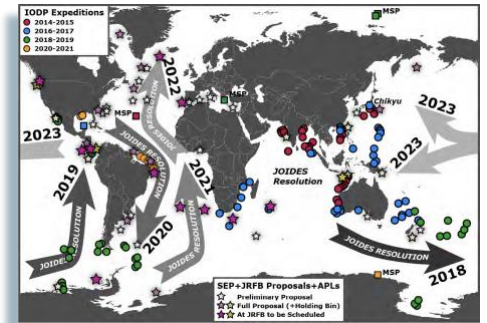


Location map of potential proposals discussed at Sydney workshop, color coded to the main IODP themes. Source: ANZIC Report 2018.

Call for Writing Workshop Applications

With the winding up of the Marine Geoscience Office (MARGO) to support Australian development of IODP, the ANZIC Office will administer the remaining MARGO funds to ensure pre-proposal development is progressed to submission from the highly successful Australasian IODP Regional Planning workshop held in Sydney in 2017.

A total of \$9000 is available to support between 2-3 small writing workshops hosted by Australian ANZIC researchers. The aim of the support is to facilitate and/or leverage additional institutional support to hold a proposal writing workshop with the aim of submitting a pre-proposal by the next IODP deadline (April 2019).

Application Process.

- Applications are open only to Australian-based researchers affiliated with ANZIC institutions.
- Applications should be completed on the template provided on the ANZIC website: <https://iodp.org.au/for-scientists/funding-opportunities/> and should have direct reference to the proposals in the Australasian IODP Regional Planning workshop held in Sydney in 2017 and include ECRs and uphold diversity and equality principles.
- The funding can only be allocated to the travel and accommodation costs of ANZIC participants or Aust. researchers to attend the writing workshop and basic meeting-related catering. We recommend and encourage the funds are used to leverage against your own institutional sources to invite overseas participants.
- Applicants can indicate if they would like to use the ANZIC Office facilities to host the meeting in Canberra and if they seek input from the ANZIC Office on how to submit pre-proposal submission as a part of their writing workshop.
- Applications should be no longer than 3 pages.
- Applications should be submitted to the ANZIC program scientist (anzic.programscientist@anu.edu.au) by 12 noon, 10th September 2018 and will be assessed by a sub-committee of the MARGO and ANZIC Scientific committees.
- Outcomes will be announced mid-October 2018 and must be expended by mid-March 2019, with an explicit aim of having a pre-proposal submission to IODP by the April 2019 deadline.
