- letter of support from your supervisor (should you be an undergraduate, graduate, or PhD student).

Please ensure, that your application is complete and strictly follows the guidelines outlined above.

If you are accepted, ANZIC will finally support your travel, accommodation, food & participation fee. You will need to get insurance from your home institution.
